



2021-22 Gender Pay reporting

Minor, Weir and Willis



Overview

Minor, Weir and Willis operates within the fresh produce sector. This Gender Pay Gap Report is based on data as at 5th April 2021. At this date, Minor, Weir and Willis employed 367 staff with 261 [71%] being male and 106 [29%] being female.

Our overall mean gender pay gap is 10.30%.

Median hourly pay difference between male and female employees is -2.1%.

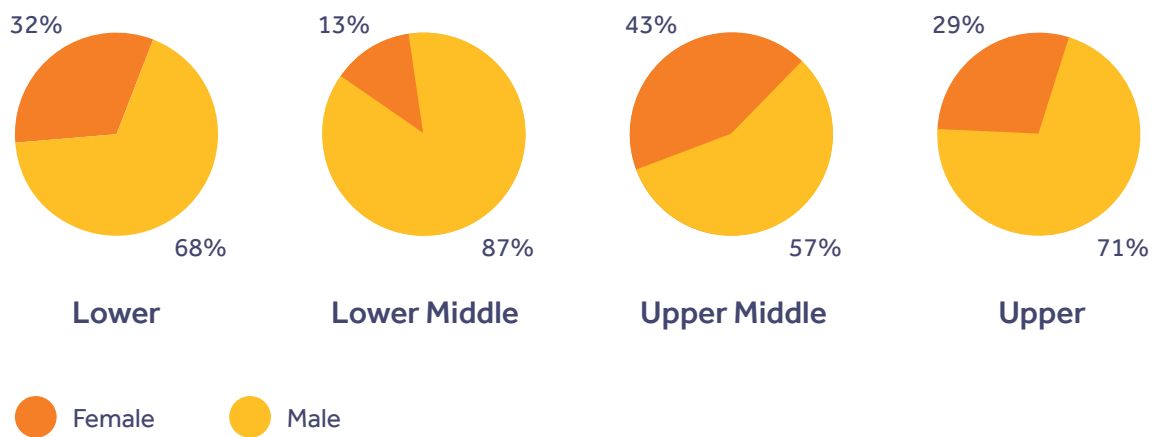
Production operatives are paid the same rate according to the role they do. We have an equal pay policy there is no difference between the rates paid to men and women occupying equivalent roles.

Employee Bonuses

Mean bonus difference between male and female employees 53.6%, Median bonus difference between male and female employees 0%.
